According to the international media, the European Union was shaken by a "political earthquake" in May 2014. The source of that earthquake was the electoral success of so-called "anti-EU parties" in general, and far right parties in particular. But while it is true that unprecedented results were obtained by some far right parties, the overall result was not that remarkable. This lecture will look at the results of the far right in a broader historic and regional perspective, arguing that the political earthquake was highly local and will leave few broader ripple effects.
